The Pennsylvania State University Poultry Science Club won the 2008 National Club of the Year Award and the Best Scrapbook Award at the International Poultry Exposition held in Atlanta, Georgia, on January 23-24, 2008. In addition, Tami Topper, a senior Animal Sciences Major/Poultry & Avian Sciences Minor from Gettysburg, PA, was named runner-up for the 2008 Student of the Year Award. Thus, the Club came very close to repeating last year's unprecedented sweep of all three awards from the U.S. Poultry & Egg Association's College Student Program.

This marked the third consecutive year, and the 4th time in the past 6 years, that PSU was named the National Club of the Year and the 9th year in a row that the Club has won the Best Scrapbook Award. Samantha Tartaglino, a senior Animal Sciences Major from Vienna, VA, and Megan Boyer, a senior Animal Sciences Major from Selinsgrove, PA, are the Club's President and Vice President, respectively, for 2007-08.
